ABSTRACT STRUCTURE

Title: Write the title in bold Arial. The number of words available for the title is limited to 20.

List of authors: First enter the name and then the surname of the author presenting the abstract. First upper case letter and subsequent lower case letters. If the author has more than one name, enter only the first of the other names in upper case. Eg Giuseppe M Bianchi.

Affiliations: Write the name of the Division, of the Department, followed by the name of the University or research body.

Abstract: The maximum number of words available for the abstract (excluding names and affiliations) is 300. The abstract must be written in absstract 12, single spaced, structured as follows:

Enter the text for each section in the corresponding text field.

Bibliography: It must be inserted in the text, indicating the first author and the year, e.g. (Rossi et al., 2015).
